**18** Our Father in Heaven, today I choose to let Your peace rule my heart, no matter what happens to me. (Colossians 3:12-15)

**19** Lord Jesus, You are always with me. Help me cultivate an awareness of Your presence in all aspects of my life. (Mark 4:35-41)

**20** God, our loving Father, teach me to draw near to You each day in humility, repentance, faith, and prayer. (James 4:6-10)

**21** Lord, we need Your peace to live in this difficult world. Pour Your peace into our homes, hearts, and lives everyday. (John 16:33)

**22** Holy Spirit, help me fix my mind on Jesus, our Peace Giver, and trust Him for every area of my life. (Isaiah 26:3)
