



Today we celebrate the Sacrament of Holy Communion

Here our Heavenly Father promises anew His unconditional love, renews His pledge of forgiveness in Christ, and offers His Holy Spirit as strength for daily faith and life. We practice the custom the church since the time of the apostles that those who are instructed and have confirmed their faith in the common faith with the LCMS and are able to examine themselves about their relationship with God and with fellow believers may commune with us. - Do I intend by the power of the Holy Spirit to live a godly life?


