Today we honor and recognize our veterans and those who are currently serving our country in the armed forces. They have been called by God to defend and protect the people of this nation. Often at great sacrifice, they stand in the way of those who seek to harm, kill, or impose their will over others. There will come a day – the “Last Day” – when God will finally eliminate all evil and Christian servicemen and women will be able to lay down their arms forever. But until that day comes, they serve the Lord by shielding others. We thank God for them, and ask him to protect them, to help them resist temptation, and to bless and prosper their work.

As We Gather: the “Last Day”

The “Last Day” is that moment when God will end the world that we live in right now. God is patient with us, but there will come the time when he will eliminate all evil and suffering, and make a new heaven and a new earth. On that day, Jesus will appear visibly in glory and all those who have died will be raised and will be judged. What a great day that will be for us who trust in Jesus! We will be with God forever in glory, not just in spirit but with bodies that are new and perfect.

The Bible says that no one except God himself knows when the Last Day will come. God is waiting, holding off on the Last Day so that more people may come to faith and be saved. But sooner or later his patience will come to an end. So don't be discouraged by all the evil in the world today! It will all come to an end. And take advantage of the time God is allowing us: put your trust in Jesus and encourage others to trust in him as well.

Epistle**2 Peter 3:1–13**

(On the Last Day, Jesus will return in glory and the earth will be destroyed and remade.)

This is now the second letter that I am writing to you, beloved. In both of them I am stirring up your sincere mind by way of reminder, that you should remember the predictions of the holy prophets and the commandment of the Lord and Savior through your apostles, knowing this first of all, that scoffers will come in the last days with scoffing, following their own sinful desires. They will say, "Where is the promise of his coming? For ever since the fathers fell asleep, all things are continuing as they were from the beginning of creation." For they deliberately overlook this fact, that the heavens existed long ago, and the earth was formed out of water and through water by the word of God, and that by means of these the world that then existed was deluged with water and perished. But by the same word the heavens and earth that now exist are stored up for fire, being kept until the day of judgment and destruction of the ungodly.

But do not overlook this one fact, beloved, that with the Lord one day is as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day. The Lord is not slow to fulfill his promise as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing that any should perish, but that all should reach repentance. But the day of the Lord will come like a thief, and then the heavens will pass away with a roar, and the heavenly bodies will be burned up and dissolved, and the earth and the works that are done on it will be exposed.

Since all these things are thus to be dissolved, what sort of people ought you to be in lives of holiness and godliness, waiting for and hastening the coming of the day of God, because of which the heavens will be set on fire and dissolved, and the heavenly bodies will melt as they burn! But according to his promise we are waiting for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells.

And Jesus began to say to them, "See that no one leads you astray. Many will come in my name, saying, 'I am he!' and they will lead many astray. And when you hear of wars and rumors of wars, do not be alarmed. This must take place, but the end is not yet. For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. There will be earthquakes in various places; there will be famines. These are but the beginning of the birth pains.

"But be on your guard. For they will deliver you over to councils, and you will be beaten in synagogues, and you will stand before governors and kings for my sake, to bear witness before them. And the gospel must first be proclaimed to all nations. And when they bring you to trial and deliver you over, do not be anxious beforehand what you are to say, but say whatever is given you in that hour, for it is not you who speak, but the Holy Spirit. And brother will deliver brother over to death, and the father his child, and children will rise against parents and have them put to death. And you will be hated by all for my name's sake. But the one who endures to the end will be saved."
