





"The stone that the builders rejected has become the cornerstone; this was the Lord's doing, and it is marvelous in our eyes'?"





Today we celebrate the Sacrament of Holy Communion

- 4. Do I intend, with the help of God, to live a life that is pleasing to God?


We believe that your "yes" to these questions indicates a common faith with our Christian congregation and, therefore, we invite you to receive Holy Communion with us.

- Children and those not communing are welcomed to come forward for a blessing, but are not given communion until they have completed basic instruction classes on the Christian faith.




JOB OPENING
